1. Recommended List of Possible Park Names

Background: The City of Milpitas has a number of new City parks, indoor and outdoor facilities included in current and future developments. This influx has resulted in the need to establish a list of approved park names. When considering persons to add to the list, the following can be considered:

- Names of historic groups or individuals
- Deceased Veterans
- Lifelong Community Leaders
- Influential Citizens in the formation of Milpitas
- Founders of Community Organizations
- Outstanding Elected Officials
- Groundbreaking "Firsts" of Milpitas

Currently, developers building a new City Park currently referred to as Montague Village is requesting a name for the Park. As part of the discussion staff is asking for a name recommendation specific to this park.

Recommendation: 1) Discuss and begin developing a City Park Naming List and 2) Recommend a name for Montague Village Park.

1. Memorial Bench Request for Charles Loughborough

Background: Staff received the Park Donation/Dedication application from Milpitas Resident family, the Loughborough's. Their son, Charles passed away unexpectedly on February 3, 2015. He was 43 years old. The family is requesting a bench be placed in Augustine Park in his memory for his service to the community, Sunnyhills neighborhood and his family.

Recommendation: Review the Park Donation/Dedication application and recommend the installation of a memorial bench for Charles Loughborough in Augustine Park for final City Council approval.

2. 450 Montague Park Name

Background: At the April 21, 2015 City Council meeting, staff presented the Commission's recommendations for naming the park either J.W. Johnson, Captain Calvin Valpey, O.H.P. Vennum or Charles Beverson. City Council directed the Commission to choose one name for recommendation and final City Council approval.

Recommendation: Discuss and recommend one name for 450 Montague Park for City Council final approval.
