1. HUIZHOU CITY, CHINA: STATUS REPORT ON SISTER CITIES RELATIONSHIP

Background:

Lead Commissioner: Chair Grilli

- Milpitas and Huizhou signed an updated MOU in September 2008 for a five-year term.
- Continue discussions regarding possible student exchanges between Milpitas and Huizhou.

Recommendation: Receive verbal report from Lead Commissioner Grilli.

2. DAGUPAN CITY, PHILIPPINES: STATUS REPORT ON SISTER CITIES RELATIONSHIP

Background:

Lead Commissioner: Mateo

- Milpitas and Dagupan signed an updated MOU on September 15, 2009, for a five-year term.
- Continue discussions regarding possible exchanges between Milpitas and Dagupan.

Recommendation: Receive verbal report from Lead Commissioner Mateo.

4. TSUKUBA CITY, JAPAN: STATUS REPORT ON SISTER CITY RELATIONSHIP

Background:

Lead Commissioners: Arbaugh & Tran.

- Milpitas and Tsukuba signed an updated MOU in August 2009, for a five-year term.
- Visits between Milpitas and Tsukuba will not take place in 2010. Discussions are underway for the 15-year sister city anniversary in 2011. Tsukuba is looking for exchange ideas that do not include travel. A photo contest/exchange is being proposed between the cities.

Recommendation: Receive verbal report from Staff Liaison Cuciz & Lead Commissioners Arbaugh and Tran.

5. NAM-GU CITY, INCHEON, SOUTH KOREA: STATUS REPORT ON FRIENDSHIP CITY RELATIONSHIP

Background:

Lead Commissioner: Chen

- A government delegation from Nam-gu visited Milpitas on July 28, 2009. A Signing Ceremony was conducted and the Mayors of both cities signed an open-ended Friendship Agreement.
- Mr. David Chang, the Co-Chairman of the Korean-American Federation of Southwest States (located in Santa Clara) is the local contact for Nam-gu.

Recommendation: Receive verbal report from Lead Commissioner Chen.

6. WESTERN EUROPEAN SISTER CITY RESEARCH STATUS REPORT

Background:

Lead Commissioners: Arefi, Arbaugh & Serpa.

- Altopascio, Italy: Commissioner Serpa is working with her contacts in Italy. Vice Mayor McHugh and Commissioner Serpa are continuing to research sister city opportunities throughout Italy.
- Karlshamn, Sweden: Staff sent an email on April 9, 2010, with information about Milpitas and the sister cities program to the Karlshamn contact provided by Commissioner Arefi. Staff is awaiting a response. (Lead Commissioner Arefi)
- Arbus, Denmark: Staff emailed information on Milpitas in early March and has not received any response. Arbus noted on the Sister Cities International (SCI) website, that they are seeking a sister city. The U.S. was listed in the third position in terms of their preferred country for a sister city. (Lead Commissioner Arefi)

- Derby, England: In May 2009, Vice Chair Arbaugh requested a discussion about Derby, England. He made contact with John Forkin, Director of Marketing Derby. Staff sent a letter and informational packet to Derby in June 2009. To date no reply has been received. (Lead Commissioner Arbaugh)
- Commissioners Arefi, Arbaugh and Serpa are continuing research on the potential for other western European sister cities.

Recommendation: Receive update from Lead Commissioners Arefi, Arbaugh and Serpa.

7. NON-VOTING STUDENT MEMBER

Background: On September 15, 2009, the Sister Cities Commission bylaws were amended by the City Council to allow for a non-voting student member on the commission. Currently, no students have submitted an application to participate. The commission has noted that a student member position is temporary and is mostly needed during student exchanges. None are planned at this time. MUSD Liaison Alisantosa is expected to provide an update at the next meeting on his report to the MUSD Board.

Recommendation: Receive status update and remove from agenda until a student exchange is scheduled.
