Documents required at time of intake appointment:

- **Valid Identification.** (Passport, Military ID or Valid State ID.)
- **Social Security Card** (of each family member residing in the household)
- **DD Form 214**
- **Verification of ALL Household Income** (Disability, Pension, Retirement, Wages, Investments, Interest Barring Savings, Public Assistance)
- **Bank Statement**
- **Copy of current lease**
- **Verification of Residence** (if homeless, letter from shelter, institution, or transitional housing facility on company letterhead)
- **Eviction notice** (if applicable)

Participant Eligibility

- **Veteran Family:** Veteran who is a single person, or Family in which the head of household, or the spouse of the head of household, is a Veteran.
- **Very Low-Income:** <50% area median income.
- **Must meet the “if not for assistance” clause.**

Status Requirements:

- **Category 1:** Currently residing in permanent housing and is at-risk of becoming homeless.
- **Category 2:** Currently homeless, scheduled to become resident of permanent housing within 90 days.
