1. Spelling Bee Debrief

Background: On January 23, 2015 the Youth Advisory Commission hosted a successful Spelling Bee Event. Over 40 participants were served and the event promoted wellness in the community. The Commission sold 68 tickets for the event (children under 5 were free) raising \$340 dollars; in addition, \$200 was raised from the participant registration fees.
