A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILPITAS CALLING A MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2008, AND REQUESTING THE SERVICES OF THE SANTA CLARA COUNTY REGISTRAR OF VOTERS AND CONSOLIDATION OF SAID ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted Chapter 200 – 1.00, Title I of the Milpitas Municipal Code pursuant to California Elections Code §1301, determining that all General Municipal Elections shall be held on an established election day; and

WHEREAS, there is a Statewide Election to be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2008; and

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is necessary to fill the offices of Mayor and two Members of the City Council, whose terms are expiring:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

1. That a General Municipal Election shall be held and consolidated with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 4, 2008.

2. The offices to be voted upon at such election are as follows:

- Office of Mayor** of the City of Milpitas, full term, two years
- Member of City Council** of the City of Milpitas, full term, four years
- Member of City Council** of the City of Milpitas, full term, four years

3. The City Council of the City of Milpitas requests the Board of Supervisors of Santa Clara County to consolidate the Milpitas General Election with the Statewide General Election and to further provide that the canvass of election returns be made by the Board of Supervisors of Santa Clara County.

4. Election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officers shall be the same as provided for the Statewide General Election to be held on November 4, 2008, and the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters is authorized and instructed to certify the returns of the municipal election.

5. The City Clerk shall publish a “Notice of Election” pursuant to California Elections Code §12101.

6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to deliver certified copies of this Resolution to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Santa Clara County and the Registrar of Voters of Santa Clara County promptly upon its adoption.
