Subject: City Council Subcommittees

Date: December 7, 2008

As I mentioned in my presentation to the City Council and the public at the December 2nd meeting, I am asking the City Council to reduce the number of Council Subcommittees from ten to five. All current subcommittees would be eliminated and replaced with these five:

Rules

Finance

Economic Development

Neighborhood Services and Education

Transportation and Land Use

I am suggesting that the Rules subcommittee assume the duties of the Open Government and Facilities Naming Subcommittee along with other duties relating to City Council agenda review. The new Finance subcommittee will handle items formerly heard by the Utility Rate and City Attorney Subcommittees. The Neighborhood Services and Education Subcommittee would hear items that the CIP and Senior Facilities Subcommittees formerly did. The Library Subcommittee will disband.
