Found October 17, 2000. The Milpitas Arts Commission serves as an advisory body to the City Council on matters pertaining to the Arts, performance or visual in the City of Milpitas. The Commission reviews Phantom Art Gallery artist applicants, and reviews the Cultural Arts Support Program. The Milpitas Unified School District also has a voting member appointed to the Commission. *The Commission shall hold regular meetings on the fourth Monday at 6:00pm on alternating months, January, March, May, July, September and November. Should a scheduled meeting occur on a holiday, said meeting will be deferred to the same day of the following week. All meetings shall be open to the public. Special meetings of the Arts Commission may be called by majority of the members, Chairperson, or City Council. Notice of any special meeting shall be given as required by law. The Arts Commission will follow Robert's Rules of Order.*
