Explain the reason for the budget change:



One of the Public Art Committee Master Plan categories is "Street Art" which would include art visible from Milpitas' major roads and streets. The Committee has identified a possible Street Art project, which would artistically enhance an existing transit shelter on Main Street. This Shelter is the first of six City-owned transit shelters on Main Street is located at the southern end of Main Street and Montague Expressway.

The Shelter is adjacent to the Great Mall of Milpitas and directly in front of new Condominium Development, "Centria" in Milpitas. The Public Art Committee has researched similarly commissioned projects in other cities and found them to be a great success and a wonderful addition to a City's Public Art Portfolio.

Enhancements to the transit shelter may include, glass etching features, murals, benches, etc. The project is estimated at costing no more than \$7,000 and is hoped to be one in a series of transit shelters planned down Main Street.

Fiscal Impact: A budget appropriation in the amount of \$7,000 from the Public Art Fund. Sufficient funds are available in the Public Art Fund.
