A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILPITAS IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA’S PLANS FOR A NEW STADIUM THAT WOULD BE HOME TO THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS NATIONAL FOOTBALL LEAGUE FRANCHISE

WHEREAS, the City of Milpitas would reap significant economic benefits for local businesses and hotels, new jobs and development opportunities from a new state-of-the-art multi-purpose stadium in the City of Santa Clara that would be home to the San Francisco 49ers (“49ers”) National Football League franchise; and

WHEREAS, the 49ers have identified the City of Santa Clara as their principal choice for a new stadium; and

WHEREAS, the proposed site for the 49ers’ football stadium in Santa Clara is immediately accessible by multiple transportation options, including bus, lightrail, ACE, Amtrak and CalTrain; and

WHEREAS, the term sheet agreement reached by the City of Santa Clara and the San Francisco 49ers calls for no taxes on local residents and no negative impact on Santa Clara’s general fund; and

WHEREAS, the 49ers community outreach programs and 49ers Foundation have provided significant benefits to youth and families throughout the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Milpitas hereby resolves to support the development of the 49ers’ football stadium in the City of Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, California.
