

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILPITAS REQUESTING THE SANTA CLARA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO PLACE A PLAQUE OR OTHER COMMEMORATIVE AT THE NEW VALLEY HEALTH CENTER MILPITAS RECOGNIZING DR. ALBERT CURRLIN

WHEREAS, Dr. Albert R. Currilin started his practice in Milpitas in 1935; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Currilin was the only doctor in Milpitas for 20 years, serving as a general practitioner, and he continued serving the Milpitas public for a total of 37 years until closing his private practice in Milpitas in the early 1970s; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Currilin’s medical activities have continued and include serving on the staff of Alexian Brothers, O’Connor and San Jose hospitals, serving as the first Staff President at Alexian Brothers Hospital and Staff President at San Jose Hospital, and as president of the County Academy of General Practice, the County Medical Society, and the County Heart Association; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milpitas wishes to effectuate appropriate recognition of Dr. Currilin’s distinguished career, his role in Milpitas’ history, and his significant service to the City of Milpitas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milpitas deems the new Valley Health Center located in Milpitas to be an appropriate location for a plaque or other commemorative recognizing Dr. Currilin to be placed in a prominent location visible to the public; and

WHEREAS, the new Valley Health Center in Milpitas is owned and operated by the County of Santa Clara.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Milpitas hereby finds, determines, and resolves as follows:

1. The City Council has considered the full record before it, which may include but is not limited to such things as the staff report, testimony by staff and the public, and other materials and evidence submitted or provided to it. Furthermore, the recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. The City Council hereby adopts a resolution requesting the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors to place a plaque or other commemorative in a prominent location visible to the public at the new Valley Health Center located in Milpitas, appropriately recognizing Dr. Albert Currilin.
3. The City Council hereby directs staff to work with County personnel to effectuate the creation and placement of the plaque or other appropriate commemorative.
