RE: Milpitas Rotary Club's Proposal for Annual Pumpkin Patch and Carnival


Please accept this letter as replacing the letter dated September 1, 2010 submitted by Todd Flesner for the Milpitas Rotary Club requesting fee waiver for the Rotary Carnival. As the Rotary Club is also requesting waiver of fees for its Annual Pumpkin Patch, the City has suggested that the two events be considered at the same time by the Mayor and City Council at its October 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**Annual Pumpkin Patch:** The Pumpkin Patch is scheduled for October 22<sup>nd</sup> through October 30<sup>th</sup> and will be located at the same location as previous years, the Milpitas Unified School District Parking Lot on East Calaveras Boulevard. The Rotary Club requests that the City approved the Pumpkin Patch and waive the fess for the event.

**Rotary Carnival:** In partnership with Butler Amusement, Inc, the Milpitas Rotary Club is planning to host a community carnival from October 21 – 24<sup>th</sup>. The event is scheduled to take place in the Wal-Mart parking lot, 301 Ranch Drive in Milpitas. The Club requests that the Mayor and City Council waive all identified fees, such as Fire Department, site inspection and electrical generator permit fees.

The Rotary Club uses proceeds from the Pumpkin Patch and Carnival to provide financial assistance to local charities and groups, such as the Food Pantry, The Family Giving Tree, the City's Teen Center and school programs. Waiving the fees will allow the Club to decrease its expenses and focus more of the proceeds on Milpitas community services.
