### Alviso Adobe Park Old Farm Wagon Sculpture

Steel and Bronze 1850's farm style wagon sculpture displaying symbolically a crate with apricots. The wagon's bed has engraved text and images depicting the history of the site functioning like an interpretive sign. The wagon structure can be a new manufactured piece, a combination of old and new parts or an authentic 1850's wagon restored with creative added elements to integrate into the revived image of the Alviso Adobe Park.

# The Alviso Water Tower

Approximately... 6 feet tall x 2 feet square  
Weight is under 200 lbs.

Constructed of an angled, powder-coated steel framework, photo-tiles & aluminum panels attached to steel framework and coated to withstand the elements.

The water tower represents all of what the Adobe was and more. Water from the tower provided "life" to all living things; the animals, the plants, the people. Without water the Adobe would cease to exist... water had to be plentiful for all to survive or the settlement would be useless.

I have made the tower to include elements of the Alviso Adobe's history, including the Native Americans who settled here before the Alviso family. It is a "tower" of the Alviso family history AND an important part of the history of Milpitas herself.
