

Alviso Adobe Park Old Farm Wagon Sculpture

Steel and Bronze 1850's farm style wagon sculpture displaying symbolically a crate with apricots. The wagon's bed has engraved text and images depicting the history of the site functioning like an interpretive sign. The wagon structure can be a new manufactured piece, a combination of old and new parts or an authentic 1850's wagon restored with creative added elements to integrate into the revived image of the Alviso Adobe Park.

- Finalist Carla Moss proposed art project “Alviso Water Tower.”
- The piece would be a tower of photo-tiles and aluminum panels attached to a steel framework. The photo tiles would include elements of the Adobe’s history.
- Project budget is estimated at \$20,000.
