

RESOLUTION NO. 84__**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILPITAS CONFIRMING CANVASS OF RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014, PURSUANT TO ELECTIONS CODE §10262**

WHEREAS, the Registrar of Voters of Santa Clara County has duly canvassed the votes cast in the City of Milpitas in the General Municipal Election held on November 4, 2014, by the electors of the City for the candidates hereafter set forth and has certified to the City Council the results of the votes cast at the election for all candidates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Milpitas as follows:

1. On November 4, 2014, a General Municipal Election was held in the City of Milpitas for the office of Mayor, and for the office of two Members of the City Council. The municipal election was consolidated with the 2014 Gubernatorial Statewide Election and, pursuant to law, the canvass thereof was conducted by the Registrar of Voters of Santa Clara County, California.

2. The canvass and the results of the November 4, 2014, election are hereby received, confirmed and approved, and the City Council finds and determines that the total number of votes cast in the City at the 2014 General Municipal Election and the total number of votes given in each precinct and by vote-by-mail voters of the City for each candidate is set forth in the final canvass and is shown on the election results, attached to this Resolution.

3. At the municipal election, the total number of votes cast in the City for each of the candidates including vote-by-mail, precinct and write-in votes was as follows:

5. Marsha Grilli and Garry Barbadillo received the highest number of votes cast for the office of Member of City Council and these two persons are thereby elected to that office for a term of four years each.
