**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILPITAS
AMENDING THE CLASSIFICATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Milpitas has a Classification Plan adopted as Resolution No. 1626 on December 17, 1968, which has been from time to time previously amended, and which is in accordance with the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the City of Milpitas (Resolution No. 792, as amended); and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Classification Plan are necessary to account for changes within the organization, reductions in staffing, transfer of duties, new job responsibilities, and adjustments to salary ranges.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Milpitas hereby finds, determines and resolves as follows:

1. The City Council has considered the full record before it, which may include but is not limited to such things as the staff report, testimony by staff and the public, and other materials and evidence submitted or provided to it. Furthermore, the recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. Resolution No. 1626, as amended, is hereby amended effective September 15, 2015 as follows:
 - A. The classification of "Maintenance Custodian" is reclassified to "Maintenance Worker" within the Public Works Department to better reflect the work and responsibilities of that position.
 - B. The classification of "Administrative Analyst" position is added to the Public Works Department's authorized position list for the purpose of performing a variety of responsible administrative and analytical assignments in the support of the improvement of management functions.
