I, Mary Lavelle, City Clerk of the City of Milpitas, do hereby certify to the City Council of the City of Milpitas that the signatures presented on the referendum petition for a ballot measure entitled “Referendum Against A Resolution Passed by the City Council Resolution No. 8532” are sufficient. Proponents of the measure filed 146 petition sections containing 3,777 signatures with the City Clerk’s office on April 14, 2016. Upon review of 3,496 signatures that were verified, 2,541 were determined to be from qualified registered voters in the City of Milpitas. That quantity is more than 10% of the number of registered voters in Milpitas at the time of the last report of Registration to the California Secretary of State petition and as of the date the petition was filed with the City Clerk. Therefore, the petition is certified as to sufficiency of the number of signatures.

The referendum petition submitted to our office on April 18, 2016, contained 3,777 signatures. Based on the registered voters in the City of Milpitas as of the last report of registration to the Secretary of State (Election Code Section 2187) the petition needs 2,422 valid signatures to pass.

Your jurisdiction requested that the Registrar of Voters examine and verify each signature filed. The Registrar of Voters verified all 100% of the signatures filed in accordance with Election Code Section 9114, within 30 days from the date of filing of the petition, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, and from the records of registration ascertain whether or not the petition is signed by the requisite number of voters.

The verification results of 100% of the signatures submitted found 2,541 signatures were valid. Your jurisdiction required 2,422, therefore the petitions is sufficient.
