2005/2006 rates become effective for utility bills issued on or after October 1, 2005 for meters read on or after September 19, 2005.

2006/2007 rates become effective for utility bills issued on or after August 7, 2006 for meters read on or after July 24, 2006.

* Water service for fire services provided by detector check valves shall be used solely for the purpose of fire protection and testing of such fire protection systems. In the event that water service provided by detector check valves is used for purposes other than such purposes, a quantity charge of \$14.75 per hundred cubic feet shall be imposed for water use that exceeds one hundred cubic feet per billing cycle.

- a) Flat Rate: For non-residential accounts, there shall be a flat rate assessed every billing cycle during which normal billing takes place, regardless of the amount of sewage discharged, to defray billing and sewer system administration costs. Bimonthly flat rate charge shall be as follows.
