NOTICE OF BALLOT MEASURE
ON THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 BALLOT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that consolidated with the scheduled General Municipal Election to be held in the City of Milpitas on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, the Milpitas City Council on August 4, 2020 adopted Resolutions calling for one ballot measure with an Ordinance to be voted upon by Milpitas voters. The ballot measure question is:

City of Milpitas Public Services Measure To provide funding to maintain the City's finances and services, including: police and fire protection, 9-1-1 emergency response, and natural disaster preparation; youth, senior, and recreation services; repairing park equipment and maintaining parks and recreation centers; and attracting and retaining local businesses; shall the measure, establishing a 1/4¢ sales tax, providing approximately \$6,500,000 annually for 8 years, requiring independent audits, citizens' oversight committee, all funds spent locally, be adopted? The ballot measure proposes a general-purpose tax and requires 50% + 1 voter approval to pass.

Ballot arguments in favor or opposed to the measure, limited to 300 words, may be submitted to the Milpitas City Clerk no later than Tuesday, August 11, 2020 at 5:00 PM. Rebuttals to the arguments in favor or opposed, limited to 250 words, may be submitted to the City Clerk no later than Tuesday, August 18, 2020 at 5:00 PM. In addition, the City Attorney shall prepare an impartial analysis for the ballot measure of no more than 500 words to be submitted to the City Clerk by Tuesday, August 18, 2020 by 5:00 PM. All items referenced in this paragraph **must be submitted in person to the Milpitas City Clerk** at City Hall, 455 E. Calaveras Blvd., Milpitas, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Submitters must phone the City Clerk in advance for appointment to turn in arguments or rebuttal documents in front of City Hall main entry doors. Arguments or rebuttals may not be submitted via e-mail, US mail, overnight delivery or scanned documents.

All registered voters will be sent a Vote-by-Mail ballot from the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters. Additionally, Vote Centers will be open on Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. If you have questions about the ballot measure, call the City Clerk at 408-586-3001 or Deputy City Clerk at 408-586-3003 or send e-mail to mlavelle@ci.milpitas.ca.gov.
