Update Measure B – five school parcel tax everyone is working hard, see what happens on June 8th. – 500 signs out there, more signs coming in.

Aquatic Center Feasibility – work together jointly and go out to community, some type of financing we can go out together, when quarter cents sales tax, ask him, if everyone is in concurrence, to do more legal research on bond financing, we concluded that we do an a and b that goes together, check both boxes, may be that school district needs more majority, general use of revenue, something we can do together, scope, .

Dr. black – look at other needs as well, carpet maintain, other bond is fifteen years old, put together needs, campaign together, poll together, make arrangements for tom and I to take a look at the facility, where people will come together, restaurants, world class.

Polanski – cricket fields, they were talking about an aquatic center, as economy gets better, tap into corporations and businesses, especially what happens with 49ers and Oakland A's, hotels, Superbowl, sharks, 49ers, community, talking to corporations.

Tom – bonnie has looked into that for sponsorships, Chula Vista built an amphitheater, all advertising, Coors amphitheater, good one as we get started on feasibility, location size, what facility can we build there, lot be determination, we can get it done.

Vice mayor – what timeline are we talking about?

Dr. Black – sooner or later, pool falling apart on us. Get another year in, we need to get together soon.

Tom – from Bonnie, Jaime, and Planning, and one representative from Engineering, and John Cimino and get the initial works, and think about hiring a consulting to develop a plan.

Tom –definitely include all of that in studies, and determine what makes sense.

Althea Polanski – have staff get together in late June (after measure b).

School District expansion plans – Tom – this came from councilmember Gomez. There is any update. Zanker School, Aspen apartments – we made a move, we changed the boundaries, feed into Randall, not a neighborhood school, definitely, once that gets going, look at a high school

situation, immediately needs would be an elementary school in the transit area, looking at 100 students next year, almost reaching 10k students.

Dr. Black - District has capacity for 2k to 3k students, it's just where the capacity is. Success to Milpitas is you have a neighborhood school.

Update developments – Fairfield will be pulling permits, is only foreseeable construction project.

Althea – lift zone, Calaveras – landscaping – working with homeowners of the sixty four units, to help do improvements, so hopefully that will bring up the neighborhood. Tom – residential development is slow. Dr. Black – not safe routes from Fairfield, the way the budget is going, not sure how long we will be busing kids. Do not know how many families will be busying kids. Glad to have them, we want more students, developer fees will be good to us.

Vice mayor – controversial at the council level, supporting the decision, hopefully,

Americo we have been doing this for fifteen years, everything went well.

Good information leading up to the event, we arrived on scene, good exchange, everyone handling the kids, check walkie-talkies, phones, called all the board members.

We have Curter and Sinnott are the California distinguished schools, 8 out of 12 schools. Cal hills graduation is going to be at Milpitas high, Friday afternoon after 4 p.m., Wednesday, Thursday, Friday night and Saturday morning.
