Background: At the May 26, 2009, the Neighborhood Services and Education (NS&E) Subcommittee meeting, staff proposed the relocation of the Milpitas Teen Center from the Milpitas Sports Center to the Sal Cracolice building which will become vacant once the new Senior Center is completed in August 2010. Also present at the meeting, were a variety of community groups which included the Milpitas Food Pantry and other non-profit organizations who expressed interest in using the facility as well. The NS&E sub-committee recommended for staff and the groups to return with their proposals and recommendations for use, as well as investigating if “shared use” of the facility is possible.



Recommendation: Receive reports of the interested groups and make recommendation(s) to the City Council for future use of the Sal Cracolice Building after August 2010.
