**Background:** At the April 26, 2010 Public Art Committee meeting, the committee voted to recommend four art proposal pieces for four Art Designated areas in the new Milpitas Senior Center: Entrance Vestibule, Lobby Fireplace, Lobby Wall, Hallway. Art pieces chosen are complimentary to the center's color schemes, architecture and have subject matter pleasing to seniors.



The Senior Center Interior Art project was approved at \$25,000.00 for all art spaces. The Art Spaces, artists and art piece costs are assigned as follows:

Entrance Vestibule: Adrian Litman, “Thriving Energy” - \$8,750  
Lobby Fireplace: Adrian Litman, “Garden Fantasy” - \$4,900  
Lobby Wall: Joanie Popeo, “Our View” - \$3,900  
Hallway: Adrian Litman, “Four Seasons” - \$4,750

The total Senior Center Interior Public Art project cost is estimated at \$22,300.

Acting Senior Center Supervisor, Renee Lorentzen will present artist submitted renderings for all pieces to the subcommittee.

**Recommendation:** Recommend approval of the Public Art Committee’s Senior Center Interior Art proposal selections for final approval at the May 4, 2010 City Council meeting.
