Government's duty is to serve the public, reaching its decisions in full view of the public. Commissions, boards, councils and other agencies of the City exist to conduct the people's business. This ordinance assures that deliberations are conducted before the people and the City operations are open to the people's review.

Materials related to an item on this agenda submitted to the City Council Ad Hoc Subcommittee on Marijuana after initial distribution of the agenda packet are available for public inspection at the City Manager's Office at Milpitas City Hall at 455 E. Calaveras Blvd., Milpitas during normal business hours.
