


It's America's Night Out Against Crime!

Last year's National Night Out campaign involved residents, law enforcement agencies, civic groups, businesses, neighborhood organizations, and local officials from over 15,000 communities from all 50 states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities, and military bases worldwide. In all, over 36 million people participated in National Night Out 2009. More than 1,000 residents participated in 27 National Night Out events in Milpitas last year.

The Milpitas Police Department encourages its residents to host neighborhood parties on Thursday, August 5th 2010, to celebrate the 27th Annual National Night Out.

NATIONAL NIGHT OUT is designed to:

- Heighten crime and drug prevention awareness;
- Generate support for, and participation in, local anti-crime programs;
- Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships; and
- Send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.

Along with the traditional display of outdoor lights and front porch vigils, cities, towns and neighborhoods celebrate National Night Out with:

- Ice cream socials,
- Cookouts,
- Visits from officers of the Milpitas Police Department
