Neighborhood Beautification APPRECIATION AWARDS

“The Neighborhood Beautification Awards Program’s purpose is to build a sense of community in keeping Milpitas a beautiful place in which to live and work.”

Goal of the Awards

The Neighborhood Beautification Awards Program was established in 2000 to recognize and reward City of Milpitas residents, property owners, neighborhoods and community groups for improvements and maintenance of their properties or neighborhoods within public view.

Minimum Requirements

- One form per nominee must be received prior to August 31, of each year.
- An individual may nominate a resident, a community group, homeowner association, apartment complex, multi family unit, mobile home, business, a school that is within Milpitas City limits and may submit more than one nomination form per category.
- The properties will be judged based on appearance from the street.
- Properties in violation of building, municipal and/or zoning codes may be disqualified.
- The property will be disqualified if it has been part of a City project or belongs to a subcommittee member.

The subcommittee reserves the right to move a nomination into a different category

The Award

All nominees will receive a certificate of recognition and winners will receive a prize. In addition, the certificates will be handed out at a City Council meeting by the Mayor and pictures of the properties will be on the City website and the City cable channel.

Categories

Residential Categories are to be selected from four sections, which are Hillside Area, East Valley Floor Area, Central Area, and West Area. All properties will be judged on their visible aesthetic appearance from the street.

1. ***Attractive Residential Property***: This category focuses on a single-family home.
2. ***Attractive Multi-Family Units***: This category focuses on mobile homes, apartments, and duplexes etc.
3. ***Attractive Home owners Associations***: This category focuses on residential homes that pay homeowners association dues.
4. ***Attractive Non- residential Property***: This category focuses on non-residential properties.
5. ***Building a Sense of Community***: This category focuses on how an organization, school, club, group or person has created an environment that positively impacted the neighborhood.
6. ***Staff Choice Award***: This category focuses on case files that have been previously in violation of city ordinances and have complied or have always had a positive presence in the neighborhood.





BASM MAP




