Council-Approved Communication Policy

- Applies to Commissions
- Proposers to register; attest to adherence to policy
- HF&H receives all proposer questions

Base and Alternative Services

- ❑ Base Services
 - ❑ Services closely match current services
 - ❑ May include desirable, low-cost additions
 - ❑ Provides a baseline comparison
- ❑ Alternative Services
 - ❑ Discretionary Programs - Separate incremental pricing (+ or -) for services the Council may, at its sole discretion wish to add at the beginning of the new contract, during the term, or not at all
 - ❑ Mandated Programs - Incremental pricing to assist commercial and MFD customers in understanding new mandated services
- ❑ Types of Alternative Services
 - ❑ Required - Those requiring proposer responses
 - ❑ Optional - Innovative or cost saving proposals offered by proposers



Single Family Services - Two Options for Garbage

<p>Solid Waste – Current Services <u>Plus</u>, or “Functional Equivalent”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Single monthly rate - Unlimited service - Customer-provided 32 gallon container option - 32, 64 and 96 gallon carts available 	✓	
<p>Solid Waste – Cart System</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 32, 64 and 96 gallon carts - No rental fee - Unlimited set-out options 		✓



Single Family Services – Recycling and Organics

Program	Base Services	Alternative Services
<p>Recycling – Current Service <u>Plus</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 64 and 96 gallon carts - Company-provided carts - Expanded list of recyclables 	✓	
<p>Yard Trimmings – Current Service</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 96 gallon carts - Stickers for overages; customer 32 gallon cans 	✓	
<p>Food Scraps</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Food scraps - Food-contaminated paper 		✓



Single Family Services – Alternatives for “Extras”

Program	Base Services	Alternative Services
<p>On-Call Collection at the Curb <u>Eliminate</u> twice/yr community-wide cleanups <u>Add</u> “on-call” events/yr</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Up to 4 times per year - Scheduled at customer convenience - Large allowable set-outs <p><u>Add</u> “Bin for a Day” option <u>Possible</u> that a “Dump Day” option will not be available</p>

Program	Base Services	Alternative Services
Current Other Services <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sharps mail in - Cell phone drop-off - Curbside battery - Pharmaceutical drop-off 	✓	
Streetsweeping <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Current service level; option to change - City option to separately contract in the future 	✓	
New Added Services <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cooking oil collection, drop-off 		✓



Multi Family Services – Garbage and Recycling

Program	Base Services	Alternative Services
Solid Waste, Current Services <u>Plus</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 32, 64, 96 gallon carts and/or 1-8 cu. yd. bins - Company-provided containers 	✓	
Recycling, Current Services <u>Plus</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 32, 64, 96 gallon carts and/or 1-8 cu. yd. bins - Expanded recyclable materials 	✓	



Multi Family Services – Organics; Flexible Options

Program	Base Services	Alternative Services
Yard Trimmings, Services as of January 2016 - Continue compliance with early AB 1826 requirements	✓	
Yard Trimmings, Future Services - Add compliance with later AB 1826 requirements		✓
Flexible Collection Options - Tailor to varied housing types	✓	



Key Future Service Options, Pt 1

- Garbage Collection
 - Customer containers, unlimited
 - Cart collection
- On-Call Collection
- Recycling Collection
 - Single Stream
 - Dual Stream (Split Cart)



Key Future Service Options, Pt 2

- “Dump Days”
- Organics Collection
 - Residential Food Scraps
 - With Yard Trimmings
 - Split Cart – Garbage and Food
