
Thank you for the cooperation and assistance you and your staff provided during the October 6 – 11, 2014 cultural and student visit the City of Dagupan, Philippines.

The enthusiasm Ms. Brittan conveyed to Dagupan students, our Milpitas students and their families was evident and pleasantly motivating to everyone.


I greatly appreciate Milpitas High School's participation and look forward to coordination with Milpitas High School for future student visits.






