VII. New and Continued Business:

1. Volunteer Support Recommendations

Commissioner N. Gupta reported the item from last month's meeting discussion. Commissioner K. Bohan stated that he supported a recommendation for Mr. Robert Marini, and any interested volunteers, to volunteer time in the deployment of refurbished computers provided by the city.

Staff noted that it provided the city department that coordinated volunteer applications with the city of Milpitas. Staff noted that back ground checks would need to be made for all volunteering work with any city department.

Staff has been testing the website for malicious activity. Staff noted that recently the City of San Jose's website was tampered with a denial of services attack that took down its website operations.

Staff reported on the new microwave data link has been replaced with a 10gig uplink between Milpitas City Hall rooftop to the Milpitas sports center building. The new connection will improve the VOIP and city data services with no interruptions from environmental matters.

CAD data system has been updated to 5.5 in preparation for next spring 2016 to support 5.7.

I-Track It upgrade complete for city's building inspectors tablet systems with improved connectivity.

FEMA flood GIS map zones for Milpitas homeowners to check whether flood insurance is needed for coverage. Information will be made available via Google maps application.
