NOTICE OF WATER AND SEWER RATE ADJUSTMENTS**

The new volumetric water and sewer rates for bills due after July 28, 2014 are tabulated below. These rates are being adjusted to cover the increased cost of wholesale water and delivery of sewer services. Water and sewer rates are reviewed for annual adjustment in accordance with Milpitas Ordinances 120.46 and 208.47, adopted by the City of Milpitas on May 3, 2011.
