E. Discussion Items:

1. Safety Talk Discussion

- a) School Safety - Subcommittee discussed safety measures in place.

5. Child & Family Homelessness Relief

Subcommittee discussed the launch of the Milpitas Assistance Program on November 4, 2019, which is intended to help low to very low-income households and families.

6. Marketing /Communications

Subcommittee discussed the current coordination with City and MUSD staff on using ParentSquare and the District e-newsletter to further promote citywide programs and services. Both City and MUSD staff will continue to utilize current strategies.
