

## Pilot Rent Relief Program

The following chart represents the length of residency requirements for emergency rent relief programs in areas surrounding Milpitas. Length of residency requirement refers to the time an individual or household must reside in a specific service area before being able to access emergency relief funds.

Does not fund assistance for households moving to Gilroy, but does provide assistance for households living in Gilroy that must relocate due to eviction or displacement.
